Mobile Tables – General Care & Maintenance Instructions

NPS Mobile Tables are built to last, and with a little help from you, will stay strong and clean for years to come. Here are some tips:

To ensure table life and quality operation; check and tighten fasteners and lubricate pivot points every (6) months. Inspect welded assemblies for any cracks or failures. If unsure, it's better to remove the table from service and call us.

LUBRICATION:

- Tables may become stiff and harder to operate from food residue and become noisy. Adding lubrication shall alleviate the squeaking and also improve open and folding functions with less human effort.
- Lubricants to use: Food grade silicone spray
Graphite spray
Lithium grease (harder to apply)



If you see this logo on the cleaner bottle do not use.

LUBRICATION APPLICATION:

- Lubricate pivot points in leg top tubes & table/bench apron cups where they connect. When using a spray, hold a rag below the pivot area with one hand; locate spray tube against the top tube/cups. Gently tap to spray controlled bursts. Open and close table rapidly without engaging the down/storage locks to work the lubricant into the pivot points. Repeat again if necessary.

CLEANING TOPS AND FRAME:

- Wash tops and frame with mild soap mixed with water. Do not use abrasive soap or scrubbers that could damage the finishes over time. Take care as to not get water-based cleaner on plated metal components in excess as they will corrode over time. **DO NOT USE CORROSSIVE CLEANERS!!**

KEEP IT SIMPLE

- Regularly clean the tabletop with a gentle cleaning solution to prevent the buildup of dirt and grime. Promptly clean up any spills to prevent staining.

KEY CLEANING SOLUTIONS

- Create a solution using a mild dish soap and warm water. With a sponge, wipe in a circular motion or follow the grain of the laminate to avoid streaks.

DRYING IMPORTANCE

- After cleaning, use a dry, clean cloth to wipe the tabletop dry thoroughly. Ensure that no water is left standing on the surface to prevent damage.

STAIN REMOVAL

- For tougher stains, you can make a paste using baking soda and water. Apply the paste to the stain, let it sit for a few minutes, and gently rub with a soft cloth. Wipe away any residue with a clean, damp cloth.

WHAT TO AVOID

- Do not use abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or scouring pads.

EXTRA CARE

- If desired, you can use a small amount of furniture polish specifically designed for laminate surfaces to add shine.

PROTECT THE SURFACE

- Avoid placing hot cookware directly on the tabletop, and use coasters or placemats to protect against moisture and heat.

AVOID SHARP OBJECTS

- Prevent scratches by avoiding the use of sharp objects directly on the tabletop. Use cutting boards and caution with items that could potentially scratch the surface.



Powdercoated Steel

Chromed Steel
